IITM, Pune; 17 Nov 2017: The Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM), Pune today celebrated its 56th foundation day in a befitting manner.

On this occasion, **Prof. Nitin Karmalkar**, Vice Chancellor, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune was the Chief Guest, and **Prof. S.K. Satheesh**, IISc, Bangalore, was the Guest of Honour.

Prof. Ravi S. Nanjundiah, Director, IITM welcomed all the dignitaries and Invitees. During his welcome address, he mentioned that the fastest supercomputer in the country will be installed in the Institute by January 2018. The computer will be five to six times faster than the current fastest supercomputer, which is installed at the Indian Institute of Science, Bengaluru. The combined processing speed of the computer will be nearly 6.8 petaflops, making it the fastest in the country. The supercomputer will also help increase the speed and accuracy of monsoon forecasts, said Prof. Ravi Nanjundiah. He also mentioned about the progress of the Institute and appreciated the respective IITM scientific groups for their remarkable contributions.

Foundation day inaugural speech was delivered by the Chief Guest, Prof. Nitin Karmalkar, Vice Chancellor, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

The foundation day lecture at the ceremony was delivered by Guest of Honor, Prof. S K Satheesh, Chairman, CAOS, IISc Bengaluru on the topic entitled, "Short lived Climate Forcers: Science and Policy". He spoke about short-lived climate forces, particularly aerosols and black carbon, and the global policy issues pertaining to them.

A booklet **on Lightning: Causes, damages & Precautions** – detailing the causes of lightning and the precautions that need to be taken during lightning was released in **Marathi language today at the hands of Prof. Nitin Karmalkar,** VC, SPPU. The same booklet was released earlier in English, Hindi & Oriya languages.

On this occasion various awards were presented to the scientists, students, scientific, technical, Administrative support and other staff of the Institute. Dr. Ananthakrishnan Award for the Best Ph.D. thesis for the year 2016 was felicitated to **Dr. S.D.
